

The DCD system works by interacting with the tank gauge at the start of delivery, allowing the tanker driver to ascertain whether there is enough ullage (space in the tank) to allow the fuel to be delivered safely, without risking overfill. This information is displayed on the DCD's illuminated screen and can be printed out for added peace of mind. Additionally, a ticket confirming the amount of fuel deposited in each tank is available upon completion of the delivery.

In the rare event of an emergency during the delivery, the DCD incorporates an emergency stop switch and telephone, allowing the driver to safely halt the fuel transfer

and contact a nominated member of the site team. Furthermore, during the hours of darkness, a floodlight circuit may be activated to illuminate the equipment and surrounding area, providing clear visibility to the tanker driver.



Case Study Ron Perry & Son

The project

Following the expansion of Ron Perry's northbound and southbound service stations, it became apparent that the existing seven-year-old CCTV analogue system wasn't capable of monitoring the extended premises effectively. The new development provided motorists with additional facilities, including forecourt shops and a cafe on each site, all requiring intensive 24-hour surveillance.

Ron sought the advice of a longstanding supplier, TSG, and following discussions and site surveys, the Tokheim EYE[™] solution was selected as the replacement system.

The solution

A trial of two Internet Protocol (IP) dome cameras located above the cashier positions in the retail shops was implemented, linked to Ron's desk computer in his office on the southbound site, as well as his smartphone, and it gave him an insight into just how useful a fully expanded system can be.

After a successful trial, TSG installed the complete Tokheim EYE™ system on both forecourts, allowing full sight of the Fuel Point of Sale (POS), dispensers, café and car parks. This level of visibility allows Ron to see when queues build up in the store and make changes in shift patterns to minimise any inconvenience for shoppers.

The result

Inspired by Tokheim EYE[™]'s potential, Ron expanded the system with IP HD cameras out on the forecourt, monitoring the pumps and maximising the value of a fully integrated system for his two sites. To help further increase security, an automatic number plate recognition (ANPR) module was added, whereby the camera digitally reads number plates. Advantages include the ability to build a licence plate database of blacklisted vehicles involved in previous drive-offs, allowing the identification of potential thieves before they can leave with stolen fuel and thereby protecting the precious bottom line.

Expanding the modular system of Tokheim EYE[™] at the A19 Services is aided by the ability to add elements of the system when investment funds permit and circumstances dictate. Ron said: *"For me, the beauty of this system is that I do not have to fund the whole installation in one go, it is flexible, versatile and 'future-proof', meaning that we can make changes as the need arises".*


